



STOP THE EXPANSION OF LEEDS BRADFORD AIRPORT

Object Now! You have until July 10th

The Airport plans to increase passenger numbers from four million to seven million a year in ten years - with a massive increase in the number of flights. They want to extend daytime flying hours and relax night time flying restrictions as well as build a new terminal.

Here are some of the reasons you might want to mention:

Increased Noise and Air Pollution

LBA admits that thousands more people would have their sleep disturbed. Their health would suffer as a consequence. Public Health England say that the impacts on health would be even more serious than LBA have admitted.

Climate Change – increased greenhouse gases

LBA's plans would increase greenhouse gas emissions when there is an urgent need to reduce them. Expansion of the airport is not compatible with Leeds City Council's declaration of a Climate Emergency.

Increased Road Traffic

An extra 3 million passenger a year means 8000 more trips to and from the airport every day increasing congestion and air pollution.

Harming the Greenbelt

Leeds City Council's Landscape and Visual Impact Team has said that the new terminal building will have an adverse visual impact on the Greenbelt.

We need a new Green Economy

Although the expansion would create extra jobs, they are not the kind that Leeds needs and completely contrary to the ambition to create a 'New Green Economy for Leeds'. Also, increased tourist flights would mean more money being taken out of the local economy, threatening local jobs.
